RBI Assistant Eligibility Criteria 2024

In this segment, we'll walk you through the RBI Assistant eligibility criteria 2024 in detail.

Nationality

To be eligible, you must be:

- A citizen of India, or
- A subject of Nepal or Bhutan, or
- A Tibetan refugee who came to India before January 1, 1962, with the intention of permanently settling in India, or
- A person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, or East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India.

It is important to note that if you fall under the last three above-mentioned categories, then you must possess a certificate of eligibility that has been issued by the Government of India.

Age Limit

- You must be between 20 and 28 years old.

There are age relaxation provisions for certain categories, allowing some candidates to apply even if they exceed this age range.

Relaxation in the Upper Age Limit: Upper age limit will be relaxed as under:

Sr. No	Category	Relaxation in Age
(i)	Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe (SC / ST)	By 5 years, i.e., up to 33 years
(ii)	Other Backward Classes (OBC)	By 3 years, i.e., up to 31 years
(iii)	Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD)	By 10 years (GEN/EWS), 13 years (OBC) & 15 years (SC/ST)
(iv)	Ex-Servicemen	To the extent of service rendered by them in Armed Forces plus an additional period of 3 years subject to maximum of 50 years .
(v)	Widows/divorced women/ women judicially separated who are not re-married	Upto 35 years (40 years for SC/ST)
(vi)	Candidates having work experience in Reserve Bank of India	To the extent of number of years of such experience, subject to maximum of 3 years.

Educational Qualifications

- **Bachelor's Degree:** You must have a bachelor's degree in any discipline with at least 50% marks. If you belong to the SC/ST/PwBD category, passing marks are sufficient. Additionally, you should be proficient in word processing on a PC.
- **Ex-servicemen:** If you're an ex-serviceman (excluding dependents of ex-servicemen), you should have either a graduate degree from a recognized university or have passed the matriculation or its equivalent exam of the Armed Forces and served at least 15 years in defence.
- **Local Language Proficiency:** If you're applying for a post in a specific recruiting office, you should be proficient in the language spoken and understood in that state or any of the states under that recruiting office. This means you should be able to read, write, speak, and understand that local language.

RBI Assistant Preliminary Exam

The RBI Assistant Prelims Exam is a Computer-Based Examination with 100 objective-type questions divided into three sections: English Language, Numerical Ability, and Reasoning Ability. You'll have a total of 60 minutes to complete the exam, with each section allocated 20 minutes. The English Language section will be in English only, while the other sections will be available in both English and Hindi. Be mindful of the marking scheme, as there will be a deduction of one-fourth of marks for every wrong answer, but no penalty for unanswered questions.

RBI Assistant Main Exam

The Mains Exam comprises 200 objective-type questions across five sections: English Language, Numerical Ability, Computer Knowledge, General Awareness, and Reasoning, with a total duration of 135 minutes and specific timings for each section. The English Language section is in English only, while other sections are available in both English and Hindi. Be aware of the marking scheme—one-fourth of the marks for a question will be deducted for every wrong answer, but there is no penalty for unanswered questions. Importantly, the marks you score in the Mains Exam are crucial for the final merit list. Succeed here, and you'll move on to the Language Proficiency Test (LPT).
