



To be eligible for the Mains Exam, candidates must first successfully clear the Preliminary Exam. Ensure you're well-prepared for this updated structure to enhance your chances of success.

- **Bonafide Certificate** (if applicable, in the format prescribed by the IBPS Clerk 2024 Board, issued by the Controller/Registrar of your University/College)
- **Any Additional Documents** as specified in the Advertisement Notification

IBPS Clerk Exam 2024 - Nationality

To be eligible, you must be:

- an Indian citizen,
- a subject of Nepal or Bhutan,
- a Tibetan refugee who settled in India before January 1, 1962, or
- a person of Indian origin who migrated from specific countries (Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia, or Vietnam) with the intention of permanently settling in India.

IBPS Clerk Exam 2024 - Educational Qualifications

- Have a Graduation degree from a recognized University or an equivalent qualification recognized by the Central Government.
- Possess a valid mark sheet or Degree Certificate on the day of registration and indicate your graduation marks percentage online.
- Be computer literate, with a Certificate/Diploma/Degree in computer operations/language or have studied Computer/Information Technology in school or college.
- Preferably, be proficient in the official language of the State/UT for which you are applying (able to read, write, and speak the language).

IBPS Clerk Exam 2024 - Age Limit

- You must be between 20 and 28 years old, born between 02.07.1996 and 01.07.2004.
