Nationality

First and foremost, you must be anyone falling under one of these categories:

- a Citizen of India or
- a subject of Nepal or
- a subject of Bhutan or
- a Tibetan Refugee who came over to India before January 1, 1962, to permanently settle in India.
- a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka, East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania (formerly Tanganyika and Zanzibar), Zambia, Malawi, Zaire, Ethiopia and Vietnam intending to permanently settle in India.

Note that if you belong to any of the last four aforementioned categories, then you must hold a certificate of eligibility issued by the Government of India.

Age Limit (As on 01.06.2024)

Secondly, knowing the age criteria for the IBPS RRB Clerk Exam 2024 is a must.

- You must fall between 18 and 28 years old.

Educational Qualification (As on 27.06.2024)

- You must hold a bachelor's degree in any discipline from a recognized university or its equivalent.
- Also must be proficient in the local language as prescribed by the participating RRBs.
- And they should have basic working knowledge of computers.
