The word that seems to be wrong among the four emboldened ones is '**Exploting**' as its correct spelling is "**Exploiting**" which means making use of (a situation) in a way considered unfair or underhand.

Meaning of other words:

- **Admitted:**
confess to be true or to be the case.
- **Spyware:**
software that enables a user to obtain covert information about another's computer activities by transmitting data covertly from their hard drive.
- **Vulnerability:**
the quality or state of being exposed to the possibility of being attacked or harmed, either physically or emotionally.

Hence, the chosen option is correct.
