If all the words printed in bold are correct, mark E i.e. 'All are correct' as the answer. Because of paucity of definite historical evidence, there is also an opinion that the five Sadhaka poets were not contemporaries at all, and thus the term Panchaskha even has to be taken with a grain of salt.

The given question suggests finding the word(s) in the sentence that may be wrongly spelt or inappropriately used in the context.

The word that seems to be wrong among the four emboldened ones is '**pauceity**'.

The correct word seems to be '**paucity**' as it means **the presence of something in only small or insufficient quantities or amounts** and it is correct in the context of the passage.

Hence, Option 1 is correct.
